At TPH Academy, we make a **3-Pillar Brand Promise,** and throughout the 2023-2024 academy year, we loved to see how that promise connected with our student-athletes and families.

We promise **PARTNERSHIP**, confirmed by the fact that mentorship is most often cited in our annual feedback surveys as to what families truly value about the TPH Academy experience.

We promise **COMMUNITY**, emphasizing both breadth and depth and seeing our 2023-24 Holiday Food Drive set a TPH record of 21,000 lbs donated.

We promise **GROWTH**, demonstrated by the ownership our student-athletes take in their development, generating results such as a 16% and 17% average increase in lower and upper body power, respectively, a 40% increase in shot accuracy, and a 4x increase in speed with versus without the puck.



Marie Colpean, 7th Grade - TPH Academy Grand Rapids (Hockey), Michigan, USA

Marie Colpean is a 4.0 student-athlete finishing seventh grade with Distinguished Honors. Marie excels in the classroom and never shies away from helping her classmates and teammates. Marie is known as an excellent mentor to younger student-athletes, and her teachers, coaches, classmates, and teammates recognize her energy on the ice and in the classroom. She works diligently at any task at hand, both academically and athletically.

Marie's hard work paid off this year. She assisted her FOX Motors 12U AAA team, which elevated from struggling at the start of the season to taking home Gold at the Michigan Tier 1 State Championship against top teams in the country. She led her team in points.

Off the ice, Marie is the lead in TPH Academy Grand Rapids community service events. In honor of a former teammate who lost her battle with cancer this year. MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

He has spent over fifteen vears supporting hockey teams at the youth, Junior 'A', and international levels, serving in various coaching, scouting, and player development roles. Since joining TPH in 2017, Francis has channeled his passion for helping athletes maximize their potential by building and delivering the curriculum for what has come to be known as Coach F.A.'s Mentorship Program.

Coach F.A.'s Mentorship Program is a two-track, sportgeneral, athlete-specific web-based leadership program designed specifically for TPH Academy studentathletes. The program, which includes live and ondemand lessons, takes student-athletes on a journey to assist them in gaining the tools necessary for achieving success in sport, school, and life.


Built from what has become known in all TPH Academies as The 9 Pillars, the Foundational Track of Coach F.A.'s Mentorship Program features nine module-style on-demand video lessons and a course workbook that provides student-athletes opportunities for introspection. TPH Academy student-athletes complete each lesson as one cohort, with on-site team members facilitating group discussions following each lesson.

The more advanced Mindset and Mental Performance Track explores topics in Sport and Performance Psychology that empower the most dedicated, driven athletes to use their most powerful asset: their minds! With lessons rooted in topics such as selfawareness, goal-setting, visualization, imagery, and conscious breathing, program participants enjoy four comprehensive, live Zoom-based virtual interactions with Coach F.A. throughout the Academy year. The Mindset and Mental Performance Track incorporates video, live polls, and student-athlete engagement and participation opportunities throughout each lesson.



In 2023-2024, TPH introduced Coach F.A.'s Mentorship Program to the Ontario Hockey League's Kitchener Rangers. TPH, the official academic provider of the Rangers, made Coach F.A. available to Rangers players both live and on-demand, with all players participating in the Mindset and Mental Performance Track.


HEALTH AND SAFETY
